
We are celebrating this important moment in your life with the same pride, optimism, and joy.

FROM THE PRINCIPAL

As I began to prepare my final words to the Class of 2022, I found myself thinking deeply about what is going on here in our Country and around the World. You are all entering a world quite different from the world your parents, your teachers, or I entered upon graduating high school and college. As a nation, we face unprecedented challenges: inflation, climate change, the ongoing cultural wars, the environmental threat, and the unprecedented pricing of the housing market that is blocking many from ever being able to become homeowners. We are trying to leave behind the only pandemic that many of us have experienced and survived, even though that pandemic reminds us each day that it is here to stay. In our communities, some of us face even bleaker possibilities as we battle addiction, poverty, and a pervasive, persistent sense of hopelessness. Our scholars have lived through a time in our country where we find that the “rights” of liberty and justice for all is being challenged, yet again, by those who believe that because of the upbringing of a person or the color of their skin that they are less than or not as important as others.

It is my greatest pleasure to welcome you to the The Friendship Collegiate Academy Early College High School Annual Commencement exercise. Since 2006, I have had the awesome task of sending FCA’s young people into the world with what I hope is sage, yet practical, advice. I want my words to carry the weight of the daunting responsibility that lies ahead but still be hopeful and optimistic. Each year, I struggle with the fact that I am one of the last voices they will hear as Friendship scholars because this ceremony is, in fact, a celebration of their entrance into the adult world. In this ceremony they cross the threshold, leave childhood and childish concerns behind to grandly enter the world of university and work.


Yet even in the midst of pain and crises, opportunities bloom. There is an abundance of beauty, hope, and optimism. I see this optimistic determination everyday as I travel throughout the building. I see it as I look out in the audience at your eager, young, gifted faces, so ready to begin the next chapter of your lives. I see it in the faces of my scholars who have already obtained a year or more of college credit. I see it in the class of 2022 who have already accumulated over \$28 million dollars in scholarship money. As you can see, the world is desperately awaiting your dogged persistence, unwavering commitment, steady patience, generous compassion, steadfast responsibility, confident leadership, resolute integrity, and noble respect for humanity.

I find as I celebrate my scholars who have worked so hard to make it to this day that we have only a quick moment to celebrate before off to work you must go.

My charge to you is to take these eight essential core values—persistence, commitment, patience, compassion, responsibility, confidence, integrity, and respect, the values that you have spent the last four years mastering, and let them guide you through the successes and the failures that are to come. As Barak Obama has taught us, “Change will not come if we wait for some other person or some other time. We are the ones we have been waiting for.
