

Related Service Provider Pay Scale

Salary Scale Effective August 1, 2023

At Friendship, we deeply value our related service provider's expertise and experience. Our Related Service Provider Scale for full-time team members considers the following experience and qualifications to determine compensation. Team members also have an opportunity to earn additional compensation through awards and stipends for work performed outside of their regular responsibilities. New team members can come in at a maximum step 10.

This scale applies to the following roles: School Psychologist (12-Month), Social Worker (12-Month), and Speech & Language Pathologist (10-Month).

Applicable experience:

- Field-related experience (after licensure) in a role with similar duties and responsibilities.

Inapplicable experience:

- Internships/practicums
- Teaching experience
- Roles held prior to receiving licensure
- Part-time or contract work
- Volunteer experience

Required Licenses include:

- School Psychologist: DC OSSE School Service Provider Credential, Licensed Psychologist through the DC Department of Health
- Social Worker: LGSW, LICSW, and equivalent out-of-state licenses will be considered
- Speech & Language Pathologist: SLP-CF, SLP-CCC, and equivalent out-of-state licenses will be considered

Please note that Related Service Providers working for Friendship Online are expected to have a 35-hour work week, therefore, their compensation will be set at 87.5% of the scale.
