Vendors may submit proposals for one, two, or three projects. Each project will be evaluated and awarded independently. When

submitting proposals, vendors must submit the pricing sheet(s) for the respective project being bid on. Each Drop down for the service requests include the pricing sheet for the respective project. Please note there is a pricing sheet for EACH project the offeror is responding to.

Please note that some equipment is not E-Rate eligible but is still being included as part of the project. The ineligible items were not included in the quantities on the drop downs above. The ineligible items are under Project One: LIC-MT-3Y, LIC-SME-3YR, E3N-MT-E, E3-N-SM (or equivalent of each).

Additionally, for Project Three Cabling, the estimated total feet of cabling is 500 feet. This is an estimate based on the knowledge of the campus at the time of FCC Form 470 filing. The drop down for racks reflects the cabling project, in the event that racks and/or enclosures are a necessary component of the cabling.
